

NFHS Batting Order

- Must be declared before the line-up becomes official
- The DH can be for starting 9 positions
- Starters any re-enter once
- Substitutes cannot re-enter
- The DH and the player they are batting for are locked into the batting order
- The DH and the player (and any substitutes) can never be in the game at the same time

Traditional 10 DH lineup

- There are 10 starters
- The DH role is terminated when:
 - a defensive player* pinch-runs or hits for the DH
 - the DH or any previous DH's plays defense

* or any previous defensive player

Player/DH lineup

- There are 9 starters
- The DH role is terminated when:
 - a substitute player* pinch-runs or hits for the DH
- Only the starting DH can be the DH
- The defensive position can have any legal substitute.
- The starting Player/DH can re-enter defensively

* or a player already playing defense
